Sub: Nomination of officers for training programme on "Law for Railway officers (October 30 to November 3, 2017)

Railway officers in the course of their day-to-day working come across situations where a good knowledge of Law pertaining to various spheres of their work comes in handy. In the absence of any formal learning or training in Law as a subject, which is perhaps the case with most of the officers, there always remains a possibility of making mistakes while taking decisions.


In view of the above, a five-day training programme on "Law for Railway officers" (October 30 to November 3, 2017) is being organized at IRITM, Lucknow to facilitate participants in their day-to-day work. Speakers from various organizations including Railways and academic Institutions having expertise in their respective fields are being invited to address the participants. Sessions will include case-laws, debate and handson activities for a more enriched learning experience. The topics which are likely to be covered are :

1. Legal Frame work for Tenders & Contracts
2. Right to Information Act, 2005
3. Discipline & Appeal Rules including Railway Services (Conduct) Rules, 1966
4. Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996
5. Indian Penal Code & Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988
6. Sexual Harassment of women at workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013
7. Labour Laws – Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970, Provident Fund and Misc. Provision Act, 1952, ESI Act, 1948, Etc.
8. Consumer Protection Act, 1986 & Competition Act, 2002
9. Director & Indirect Taxes (including GST)
10. Environment Laws – as pertaining to Railway organizations, etc.
