
**Sub: Nomination of officers from all departments for "Living with Vigilance"  
a training programme in Vigilance (November 20 to 24, 2017)**

Indian Railways Indian Railways Institute of Transport Management, Lucknow is organizing a five-day training programme for **officers of all departments** other than Vigilance, called "**Living with Vigilance**" from November 20 to 24, 2017. The programme will cover inputs from Railway Board, Central Vigilance Commission, CBI and Railway Vigilance officers of various departments on how to enhance transparency and efficacy in the sensitive functions in Railways. This training will be particularly beneficial for officers dealing with **tenders, contracts and procurements of all types, recruitments and disciplinary proceedings, finance and accounting and doctors handling procurements and contracts**. An interactive and case-study based pedagogy will be followed and nominated participants are encouraged to come prepared with their experiences and examples for sharing and discussing in the forum. The topics which are likely to be covered are :

1. Basic Tenets of Vigilance for Public Servants
2. The Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 & Indian Penal Code, 1860
3. Vigilance Issues in Engineering/Works Contracts
4. Common irregularities in Works Contracts
5. Common irregularities in Procurement Contracts
6. Common irregularities in Recruitments, Appointments, etc.
7. Use of IT in avoiding Vigilance angle (e-Procurement, latest developments)
8. Disciplinary Proceedings Ensuing from Vigilance cases
9. Case Study on complicated Disciplinary Proceedings from Vigilance Cases
10. Issues related to Medical procurements, etc.

You are, therefore, requested to nominate minimum 2 officers upto SAG to attend this training programme.
