**Sub: Nomination of officers for training programme on "Law for Railway officers" (January 29 to February 2, 2018)**

Railway officers in the course of their day-to-day working come across situations where a good knowledge of Law pertaining to various spheres of their work comes in handy. In the absence of any formal learning or training in Law as a subject, which is perhaps the case with most of the officers, there always remains a possibility of making mistakes while taking decisions.


In view of the above, a five-day training programme on "**Law for Railway officers" (January 29 to February 2, 2018)** is being organized at IRITM, Lucknow to facilitate participants in their day-to-day work. Speakers from various organizations including Railways and academic Institutions having expertise in their respective fields are being invited to address the participants.

Officers may **also** be nominated for **six weeks** programme (including Project Work/Case Study preparation)(January 29 to March 9, 2018). Six-week programme is an extension to one-week programme for officers interested in carrying out a short term Project Work or Case Study preparation on "**Law**" related subject of relevance to the Railways in general. Following the completion of five-day programme (January 29 to February 2, 2018), they (officers nominated for six week training) will be relieved to their Headquarters for Project Work and will report back to IRITM for submission of their Project Report in the sixth week (March 5 to 9, 2018). The officers thus nominated should come prepared with a 500 word synopsis of the Project or Case Study they propose to do, or they would be provided with suitable topic as project work by IRITM.

You are requested to nominate 2 to 3 officers upto SAG from your department for **either** or **both** of the above-mentioned training programme.

For the purpose of TA claims, officers doing Projects/Case studies will be based at IRITM only in the first week (i.e. January 29 to February 2, 2018) and in the 6th week (i.e. March 5 to 9, 2018) and will be considered based in their regular places of posting for the intervening period. In the intervening period of four weeks, officers desiring field visits for data collection shall take permission from their controlling officers. Annexure to this letter may be given to the nominated officers for easy scheduling of their programme.
